Alt-Country Band Tern Rounders with Exciting November Lineup

ALBANY—Tern Rounders will continue to infuse the local music scene this month, with live performances at Crumbs Nite Out at the Linda on Thursday, November 12 and a return to Revolution Hall on Tuesday, November 24. The band brings their distinctive take on the American roots tradition to the live stage, with their hard-charging honky-tonk shuffles, cosmic country, and vocal-harmony-driven folk rock.

The band has undergone quite a (r)evolution in its short lifespan, from its inception as an acoustic trio to its current electric four piece formation. The vocal harmonies of Kim Noyes and Marc Clayton, who both play guitar, form the centerpiece of the band while drummer Jim Ketterer and bassist Harry Strole complete the Tern Rounders sound.

Tern Rounders has been promoting their debut album “A Different Land” at full tilt all summer, with live shows at such venues as Caffè’ Lena and the Albany Public Library Garage. The band founded and hosts a monthly “Moonlight Jamboree: Alt-country Roots Revue” the first Saturday of every month at the Bread and Jam Café in Cohoes—a series that highlights local talent in the folk-rock-country vein, with the goal of fostering a signature gathering place for the capital region’s roots music community.
